Norske Gaardnavne (Norwegian Farm Names) comp. by O. Rygh. . At the beginning of the 1900s the farms in Norway were renumbered for official purposes. A list was made for each parish in every county. They are listed in order by number. An index at the back of each volume will lead you to the parish(es) in which the farm appears. The number can also be used for finding the particular farm in the census returns. There is a volume for each county except for Opland County which is divided into two volumes. Many Norwegian Immigrants took as their surname the name of the farm on which they resided in the "old country". This work becomes a very good tool for finding the place of origin in Norway. A Topographical Dictionary of Scotland, 2 vols. by Samuel Lewis is arranged alphabetically by place (village, parish, town, etc.) It has an accurate description of all Scottish localities as they existed at the time of publication (1851), showing where a village was located in relation to its parish, or the nearest town or towns. The civil registration of births, marriages, and deaths began in 1855, at which time all the old parish registers were called in. The LDS Church has copied the parish registers of every parish in Scotland, from the earliest up to 1855, and has indexed virtually all of them--all the more reason to know your ancestor's parish.
